Our Negotiating Committee will utilize the feedback received from you in our Flight Attendant Negotiations Survey to draft our Opening Proposals. Your feedback will define our negotiating priorities in our upcoming negotiations.

We have provided for you on our website, an <u>Industry Comparison</u> <u>Summary</u> that focuses on key provisions of our Joint Collective Bargaining Agreement and those of our two largest competitors (American and Delta). We continue to monitor the industry and will update the comparison as needed.

In all cases, every effort has been made to accurately reflect the terms in the summary. In addition to the major airlines, our Negotiating Committee has been studying key provisions for Flight Attendants across the entire aviation industry, including Southwest, Hawaiian, and Alaska Airlines, as well as other labor groups on the property at United Airlines Professional Negotiators, Attorneys, and Consultants are an Essential Component to Contract 2021
